# Langley FC - A Brief History

Langley Football Club was first formed in 2010 by two local Langley estate brothers, Peter and Leon Phillips. The Phillips Brothers both had experience and professional backgrounds within the footballing industry. The brothers decided to start up a local team within their home town of Langley.

Langley FC started out as an amateur club to provide Saturday football for local talented players but since the start of the club opening, the past 12 years have seen the club continuously grow and build on its success year after year. Langley FC has become a highly successful and respected football club that has been awarded the FA Chartered Standard which recognises high quality provision.

Langley FC currently holds the record for local football, from going from the bottom of amateur park football (East Berks Division 4) to now playing Step 6 Football in the Combined Counties League via the Hellenic League. This is certainly a step up for our young club after winning every domestic local honour.

The senior team is currently managed by Aaron Samuel, assisted by William Rice-Quaidoo and Tom Ford. The Club is certainly an exciting one to be around and has ambitious plans for the future. Langley FC values family and community and is very proud of its thriving full and successful youth setup, which is overseen by Adam Rathmill and the Under 18s coached and managed by First Team Manager Aaron Samuel.

The youth teams continue to grow and progress season after season. The club has secured planning permission and hope to move to our new home in Langley in the near future. We are currently in our third season of a ground-share with Slough Town FC's Arbour Park having spent two seasons at Holyport FC.

# Westside FC - A Brief History

Westside FC was founded by Graham Holder, our current Chairman, in May 1996 and is based at West Side Church in Wandsworth. Graham travelled to the USA in 1994 with Ambassadors in Sport to coach and evangelise in San Jose, California during the 1994 World Cup. While he was there he had a vision to form a Christian football club on his return to the UK.

In 1996 this happened. With the team only having 7 players, it joined Division 5 of the Kingston & District League (KDL). By the start of the season, the team had 17 players mainly from the West Side Church youth group. In this first season the team, player managed by Graham Holder, won KDL Division 5, the Tec Cup, and the Sportsmanship Cup and were runners-up in the League Junior Cup. Not a bad start and with Dave Doran scoring 55 goals. Current 1<sup>st</sup> team manager, Steve Walters, current treasurer Peter Cox and current 3<sup>rd</sup> team manager, Alex Dowdeswell all formed a part of that very first starting 11 on the park pitches back in September 1996!

The club grew to have three adult men's teams in the KDL with brothers, friends and friends of friends joining. The 1<sup>st</sup> team progressed through the divisions of the KDL and in 1999/20 were Division 2 Champions and were promoted directly to the KDL Premier Division and won this the following season 2000/01.

The club decided to have a further season in the KDL Premier and apply for promotion to the Surrey South Eastern Combination Intermediate League (SSEC) the following season. Unfortunately, the plan went wrong when the team ended 3<sup>rd</sup>. Graham decided to take a gamble and transferred the team into the SSEC Junior 1 and it gained promotion to the Intermediate League in 2002/03.

Graham Holder remained Manager until 2008/09 and after 12 years stepped down to manage the Reserves in SSEC Junior 1. His Assistant Manager, Steve Walters took over the job of 1<sup>st</sup> team manager.

Steve Walters led the first team to the SSEC Intermediate Division 2 title in 2014/15 and Division 1 the following season gaining promotion to the Surrey Elite League when we switched to playing our home games firstly at Croydon Arena and then at AFC Croydon Athletic. In 2018/19 we finished 3<sup>rd</sup> and gained promotion to Step 6 of the National Football Structure and entered the Combined Counties Division 1. We moved to ground share with Chessington & Hook United and despite a relatively good start, our season like many others was curtailed by COVID-19. In season 2020-21 we moved to a ground sharing arrangement at Colliers Wood United FC.

Also, in 2004, the club became the first Christian team to take a Mission Tour to Senegal in West Africa. A great adventure, two years of planning and a difficult one for a Christian team in a mainly Muslim country. The tour was a great success and we returned in 2007 with an even more gruelling schedule of matches, coaching and Christian evangelism. There were some very unusual pitches and football in the jungle is a real experience! We also have connections with Romania and Sierra Leone.

We believe that our original vision to be a multi team club has blossomed over the years since 1996. The club has expanded greatly since starting youth and girls' football in 2002 under the overall control of Jane Walters. Since season 2019-20, we joined forces with Sean McInnes and have numerous teams playing in the Surrey Youth League. We now have over 35 youth boys teams from U7 to U18 with teams playing on both Saturday and Sunday. All these teams have also won numerous trophies across all levels of the Club.

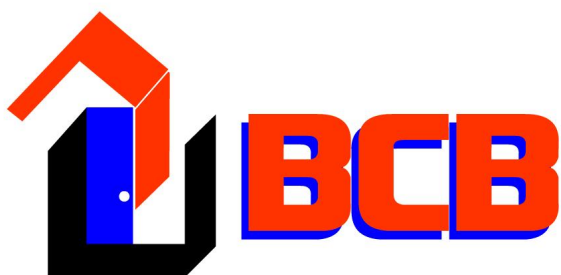
