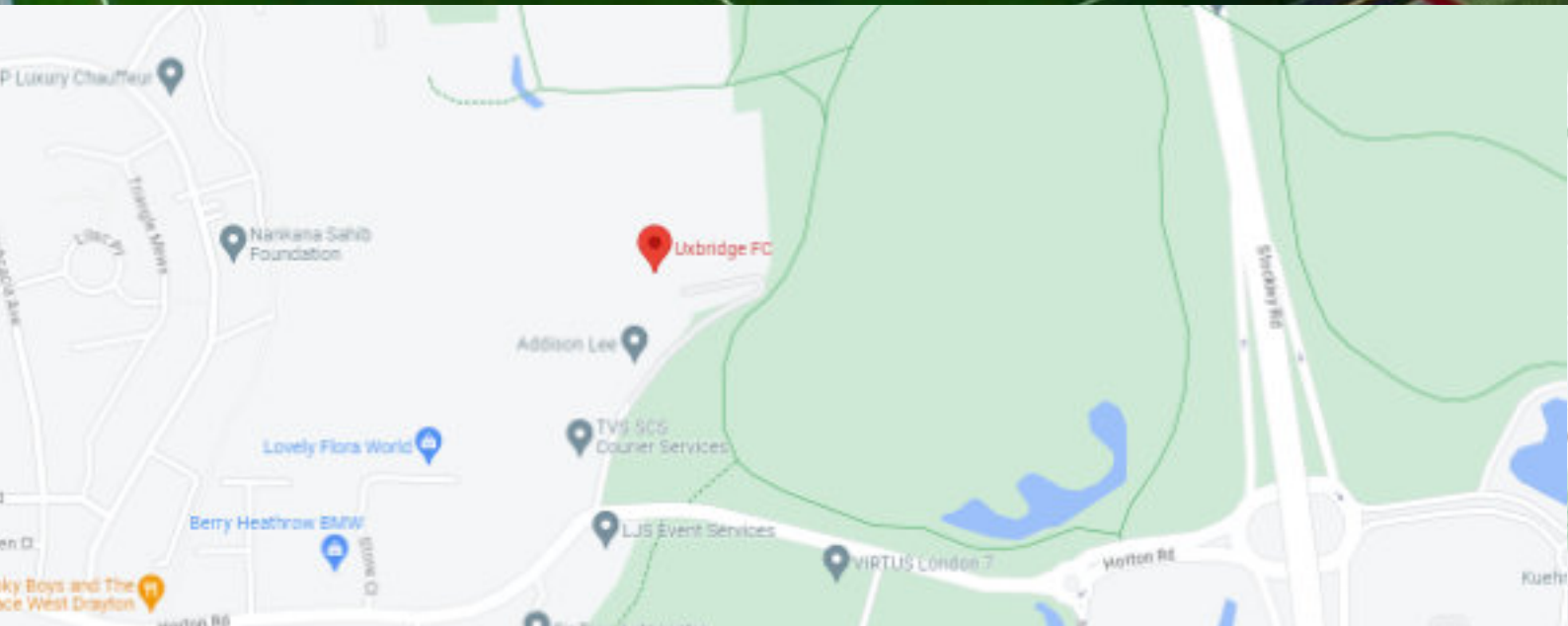

SIN BINS

Temporary Dismissals - otherwise known as 'sin bins' - are mandatory for acts of dissent across all of grassroots football.

HOW DO YOU FIND YOURSELF IN THE SIN BIN?



Players will only go into the sin bin for dissent cautions



For use of words, gestures, questioning or undermining the referee's decisions



EXAMPLES OF DISSENT:

Shouting at the referee, questioning the referee's ability, slamming the ball into the ground and sarcastically clapping a decision

DURATION OF A SIN BIN



For matches of 90 minutes, players spend 10 minutes in the sin bin



For matches of all other lengths, players spend 8 minutes in the sin bin



If the sin bin period has not expired at the end of:
1st half: Continues into the 2nd half
2nd half: Continues into extra time
Extra time: Players can participate in the penalty shoot out

THE MATCH DAY PROCESS



Dissent



Dissent caution: Referee issues a Yellow Card and directs the player to the touchline



Whilst in the sin bin, if the player commits a Yellow or Red Card offence they are sent off and can not be substituted



A player can only return to the field of play with the referee's permission at a stoppage in play



If a player receives a second Yellow Card for any type of offence, they will be shown a Red Card and dismissed from the field of play

Sin bins only apply to a player's first Yellow Card. If they receive a second Yellow Card they are dismissed from the field of play.

Offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or actions is still a Red Card offence!

Langley FC - A Brief History

Langley Football Club was founded in 2010 by two local brothers from the Langley estate, Peter and Leon Phillips, who both had professional experience within the football industry. Recognising the need for a football club in their hometown, the Phillips brothers established Langley FC as a community-centred club to allow talented local players to play competitive Saturday football. Their vision was to create a club that would not only compete on the field but would also embody a strong sense of community and pride in Langley.

Since its formation, Langley FC has grown impressively, building on each year's successes to become one of the most respected football clubs in the region. Over the past 12 years, the club has achieved a string of accomplishments and was awarded the prestigious FA Chartered Standard. This accolade recognises the club's high-quality football provision, commitment to best practices, and development of players at all levels. Langley FC's commitment to professionalism and community spirit has set it apart as a role model for other amateur clubs, creating a nurturing environment for players of all ages and abilities.

The club's ascent has been nothing short of remarkable. Langley FC holds a record in local football for its rapid progression from the lowest tier of amateur park football (East Berks Division 4) to playing Step 6 Football in the Combined Counties League via the Hellenic League, an achievement that few clubs can match. This leap is a testament to the club's ambition, drive, and determination to excel. Along the way, Langley FC has won every domestic honour at the local level, solidifying its reputation as a competitive force. This journey reflects the tireless efforts of players, coaches, and volunteers who have worked to make Langley FC a success both on and off the field.

Currently, Langley FC's First Team is managed by Michael East, who brings a wealth of experience and leadership to the role. Supporting him is Bradlee Greenwood, who oversees the Reserves and helps foster the next generation of talent. Langley FC has a vibrant youth program managed by Adam Rathmill and Lee Payne, with Demaro Woodruffe managing the Under-18s. This structured pathway for young players reflects the club's deep commitment to youth development, ensuring that young talent is nurtured and allowed to flourish. Season after season, the youth teams continue to grow and succeed, contributing to the club's exciting prospects.

In recent years, the club has grown to a point where it now requires its own dedicated facilities to meet its expanding needs. Langley FC has secured planning permission for a new home in Langley, a project that will further strengthen its community ties and provide a lasting legacy. In the meantime, Langley FC is in its second season of a ground-share arrangement with Uxbridge FC's Honeycroft, having previously spent three seasons at Slough Town FC's Arbour Park. The club eagerly anticipates the move to its own grounds, which will serve as a central hub for both its teams and supporters and will cement its place as a pillar of the local community.

Molesey FC - A Brief History

In the autumn of 1892, Dr James Jenkinson Knox, a local GP, founded the "Hampton Court and East Molesey Association Football Club." Their inaugural match took place on Saturday, September 24, 1892, against Barnes FC, resulting in a resounding 14-1 victory for the home team. The club underwent a name change in 1896, becoming Molesey Football Club.

In 1953, Molesey Football Club acquired its current location at 412 Walton Road and commenced playing there in the 1953/54 season. During this season, Molesey joined the Surrey Senior League and donned their signature White and Black jerseys for the first time. In January 1954, the club hosted their first professional team, QPR, at Walton Road, with QPR winning the game 2-1.

The 1954/55 season saw the construction of the present clubhouse, allowing Molesey to compete in the National Football Association Amateur Cup. In 1956/57, Molesey FC secured their first senior honours by defeating Farnham Town 4-1 in the Surrey Senior Charity League Cup, played at Chertsey Town FC.

The 1957/58 season marked another milestone as Molesey FC clinched the Surrey Senior League title. In 1958/59, they entered the Spartan League, enjoying their most successful season in the 14 years they spent in the league, finishing second to Staines Town. During this time, they also reached the second round of the Surrey Senior Cup, attracting a record crowd of 1553 to Walton Road.

In 1977/78, the club joined the newly established Division Two of the Isthmian League, narrowly missing out on promotion in their first two seasons. The 1981/82 season saw Molesey FC's best run in the FA Vase, reaching the quarter-finals but losing to Rainworth Miners Welfare.

In 1985/86, Chairman Gary Mayne appointed Martin Ede as manager, leading to promotion to the Isthmian League Division One and an appearance in the final of the Isthmian League Cup.

In the 1993/94 season, they reached the "proper" stages of the FA Cup for the first time, losing 4-0 at home to Bath City. However, in 1995/96, Molesey was relegated due to the FA's refusal to grant an "A" grade for their ground. The club faced challenges on and off the pitch in the following seasons.

In 1998/99, Clive Walker took on the role of Molesey's manager, and in 2002, the club was used as a filming location for "Bend It Like Beckham."

In 2007/08, Molesey faced relegation to the Combined Counties League but, thanks to the relentless efforts of Steve Webb, Peter Lelliott, and Alan Maynard, the club enjoyed a remarkable promotion to the "Ryman League." In the 2014/15 season, they secured victory in the Surrey Combination Cup and reached the final of the Surrey Senior Cup.

Steve Webb left the club in 2016/17 after a 12-year tenure, and Peter Lelliott assumed the role of manager until the 2017/18 season. Sean Boothe was then appointed manager, briefly succeeded by Craig Lewington. Regrettably, Craig and the team couldn't prevent relegation back to the Combined Counties League. In the 2019/20 season, Craig Lewington took the helm as the manager.

Through the years, Molesey has weathered both highs and lows, experiencing numerous changes on and off the pitch. Nevertheless, the club's enduring spirit remains rooted in its sense of unity and dedication, embodied by "The Mole Family."
